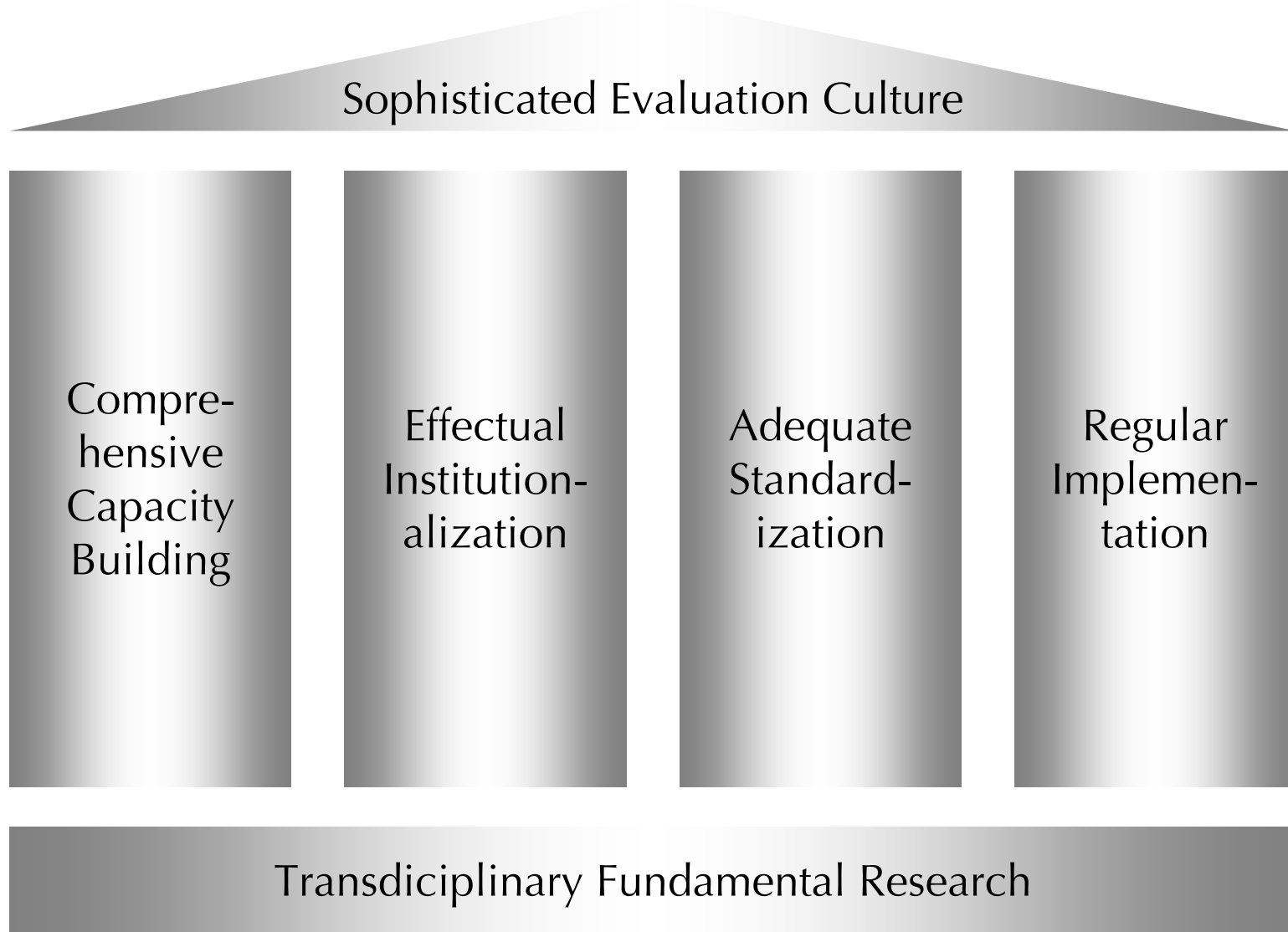

Center for Evaluation

- ✓ If it enables evaluation to do what it should do!
 - Provide insight
 - Support control
 - Initiate and establish a learning process
 - Create legitimacy
- ✓ Accounting the differences between evaluation and fundamental research
 - Evaluation always follows a practical orientation
 - Evaluation usually is not done within a scientifically controlled environment

- ✓ Comprehensive capacity building
- ✓ Transdisciplinary evaluation research
- ✓ Locally customized evaluation standards
- ✓ Institutionalized systematic knowledge and expertise management
- ✓ Regular implementation of evaluation studies



- ✓ Try a multilateral approach for the exchange of excellence
- ✓ Give evaluation a holistic perspective to enable policy advice
- ✓ Realize the potential of ex-ante evaluations
- ✓ Initiate a public discourse

- ✓ Establish obligatory agreements about the form and transparency for the utilization of evaluation results
- ✓ Define appropriate timeframes for the implementation of evaluations
- ✓ Provide appropriate resources for the implementation of evaluations
- ✓ Ensure that the allocation of evaluations follows professional standards
- ✓ Ensure that evaluators are adequately qualified
- ✓ Evaluations should comply with nationally and internationally accepted standards which are accepted by all stakeholders
